#### WORSHIP PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 2022

Reports:

Pastor Greg: Reported on his schedule for the next two months. Updates were given on communion Sundays, including First Communion on November 20 and how the distribution will be done with music. Lori asked if we wanted to ask for Canned goods donations on Thanksgiving – yes. Lori will update on Grace Notes to have donations made to Family Sharing.

Since Howard Vrankin will not be preaching on Nov. 27, Pastor Turbin will preach in his place on December 4 and Pastor Greg will now be present on Nov. 27.

Families will be lighting the Advent Candles on each Sunday starting November 27.

Pastor Greg is coordinating with Pastor Paul for a Lent skit series for the youth.

#### Eryn: Choir Report-

The Festival of Christmas Music will be on Thursday, December 8 as well as on Sunday, Dec. 11. Pastor Heidi asked if Grace wanted to join in on caroling with her churches in Cedarburg on Dec. 13 at Water Street Brewery. Eryn will check with Pastor Heidi for any issues on space.

Deb: Handbell Report -

A TV is now installed in the nursery, but no WiFi is available because of location. WiFi can be set up with a cable for around \$60, which would be considered a Worship Expense.

The YFMT didn't meet this month, but keep in touch as need be. Below is a recap of Education, Youth Groups, and other activity, and upcoming events.

#### **Youth Education**

Sunday School held Bible Olympics during Sunday School on October 30<sup>th</sup>, to go accommodate our encouragement of inviting a friend to Church, Sunday School, and Trunk-or-Treat. We had a good turnout plus some friends. Thank you to all of our Sunday School Volunteers that helped! This is one of the Sundays that is all hands on and we blessed with so many dedicated volunteers. The Sunday School rooms have good energy and we are averaging in the upper 20s each Sunday.

Confirmation is running smoothly at this time. 7<sup>th</sup> grade students will be trained to acolyte this week and will start acolyting January.

JYG and HYPE Sunday morning education hour has strong participation for both groups. They sometimes meet together as well.

#### **Youth Groups**

KFC (3rd-5th Grades) has yet to meet this year.

JYG (6th-8th Grades) will be having their JYG Thanksgiving on Sunday, Nov. 20th. They have been gathering monthly. Kate Peterman is planning service projects for them. They are organizing the Christmas Meals collection for our partners, All Peoples Church. Please watch for more information around church and support their efforts. They will also be shopping for holidays gifts far Lasata residents in December.

HYPE (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grades) will be volunteering at Bob's Under the Bridge on Nov. 17 organizing donations. They also enjoyed some fellowship together when they went bowling for their October gathering.

JYG and HYPE also sold concessions and baked goods at the COE craft Fair on November 12<sup>th</sup>. Over a \$1,000.00 was raised at the "Grace Café" these funds helps with the cost of mission and youth trips. It also provides on-site food for the vendors and shoppers. It was reported that the youth had a good flow of



people and a sense of an overall good job. Thank you to all the families that helped and all the bakers that donated baked goods. A Thrivent Grant was used to hep cover the food cost.

#### **Recap of Other Activity:**

Trunk-or-Treat (October 30<sup>th</sup>): First thank you to everyone that decorated a trunk, it is the most trunks we have seen in many years and to Brittney for planning the meal on behalf of Fellowship. We happy with the outreach effort as we saw many members and friends. It was wonderful to see so many people brought together in fellowship at Grace. Our youth did a great job with games and other activities. A Thrivent Grant was used to help cover food and supplies.

Nursery: First, thank you to Dustin, the Nursery now has a TV so we can stream/replay Worship into the nursery. A Thrivent Grant was used to help cover the cost. This allows parents to still enjoy worship if they choose to use it when there is no staff, as well as allowing the volunteer staff to see worship when there are no kids. We had the Nursery Staffed on November 6<sup>th</sup>, unfortunately it went used. However, a HUGE thank you to Brittney, Ella, Emma, Ellie, Amelia, Emmeline, and Lila for helping clean toys and start organize the nursery. This job needs to be finished still. We will staff the nursery again the first Sunday in December and revaluate our path going forward until the proper staff is hired to maintain the nursery (I would assume with volunteers still).

#### **Upcoming Events:**

First Communion (November 17/20<sup>th</sup>): Pastor Greg taught Holy Communion Instruction on November 6<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> to our 13 children, mostly in 5<sup>th</sup> grade but a few 3<sup>rd</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> graders as well. We are excited to celebrate with them receiving their Frist Communion Thursday, November 17<sup>th</sup>/Sunday, November 20<sup>th</sup>. We are grateful Pastor Greg provided opportunity to our children and their parents.

Children's Christmas Program (December 18th): In just over a week, we will be in full swing prep for our Children's Christmas Program. Thank you to Jodi Doro who is leading music (singing 3k-5th, Rainbow Bells 1-2nd, and Chimes 3rd-5th) this year and has been practicing already with the children and to Jean Fugate for leading Rainbow Bells for the 3k-5k kids.. We have 11 actors and 15 readers from our older Sunday School and Youth. All of our Sunday School Students will sing and play bells/chimes. Between services on December 18th we will have our annual Birthday Party for Jesus. Our olde youth will help run activities for the younger kids. We are using a Thrivent Grant for supplies for Birthday Party for Jesus as well as to refresh costumes in Grace's costume inventor.

#### o Treasurer

- 2023 Budget Approval/Questions
  - \$490,000 recommendation from finance team (same as 2022 actual)
  - 51 families increased their giving
  - 144 pledges (same as 2022)
  - Five first-time families pledged
  - ERTC can't count clergy. Actual amount \$69,849, available in a few months.
  - Building and grounds committee needed. \$2,951 roof repair needed. Finance committee recommends taking it from sabbatical fund.
  - No more money for staffing at 490. Finance team recommended establishing \$30k by cutting benevolence by \$20k and \$10k from ERTC.
  - Reorganize job descriptions for children/youth to accommodate a Directory of Ministry role with Erica's help working with personnel.
  - Depending on years of experience of pastor, there is a net gain or loss.
  - In 2017 giving did not match pledges and Grace would be deficit spending for next several years.
  - 20% falloff in giving in anticipation of retirement and pastor transition
  - The search for a younger children and family staff person is already underway.
  - \$9900 endowment funds Circle of Empowerment \$2000, Crossways \$500, music scholarship \$2400, adult literacy \$2500, Mount Peru coffee \$500, principal party \$2000
  - Motion made to adopt endowment funds recommendation. Seconded.
     All in favor. Motion carries.
  - Budget cuts are not related to endowment
  - Listening sessions for cutting benevolence to explain to congregation, answer questions, and initiate discussion. Add back to benevolence if we are under budget. If we want to see the church be the church it has been, this is what needs to happen.
  - Pat Murack call despite our decline in giving, we are in a good place compared to other churches. We've cut benevolence in the past in Grace and have replenished it. Need to hire on what we need now. Christmas campaign \$10k debt reduction additional for future staffing? (currently planning to ask for \$50k letter is written and planning to go out Tuesday).
  - Motion to adopt budget as laid out by finance team. Motion was seconded. All voted in favor. Motion carries.
  - Motion for \$500 gift to Sandy and \$1000 gift Dustin. Seconded. All voted in favor. Motion carries. Pastor Greg will check if memorials are designated.
  - Council approved Christmas gift for Jesus' birthday.
