Team suggested that a meeting start time be specified and held publicized, especially for those that attend 8 AM worship. Pastor Greg asked John and Dustin about adding an online option for the meeting that allows online voting. We believe James set one up last year. Does the church have a Zoom account, or did James do it?

Pastor Greg updated the team re: Katie's ministry impact on Grace and how fortunate we are that she and her family will continue to be part of our congregation, his appreciation for Erica and her willingness to take on much of Katie's roles until after we have called a new pastor. He encouraged everyone to learn from Katie's exit interview and also said that a celebration for Katie is being planned and will likely be held on 1/30.

I have no report because the YFMT didn't meet yet. Attached is Erica's report for all of the Youth Education activities. I believe the plan is for her to send her report directly in the future. I would like to express my gratitude to both Erica and Katie. They have worked very closely to create a smooth transition. Words can not express what a gift it is for Erica to take on both roles during the transition, given Grace a lot of staff building freedom for our Pastoral transition. Erica:

- Sunday School
  - Our kindergarten youth have been working hard on learning the Lord's Prayer.
    On January 16 the youth and parents met with Katie during Education hour.
  - The kindergarten kids will be leading the Lord's Prayer during the 10:30 service on Feb. 6<sup>th</sup>.



- The Education hour youth will be singing in church on April 3 during both services.
- Christmas Program Update
  - Christmas program was a success!
  - A huge thank you to our music folks (Chris Eippert, Jodi Doro and Jean Fugate) along with our parent volunteers (Adan Burgos, Sarah Newell and Jennifer Jacobson) for all their hard work! Thanks to the Newells and Flaigs for helping us share a little bit of our program with our Thursday evening worshipers.
- VBS
  - Yes, it is time to start planning for VBS
  - VBS will be August 15-19.
  - This is later than usual because the church is hosting voting the week before.
- Thrivent Grants
  - I was grateful for music, technology and fellowship folks to reach out with ideas, but I again would like to talk about a process where we continue to utilize these \$250 grants across the board.
  - We've currently applied for (and mostly already received) 48 grants in 2021, for a total of \$12,000 toward events, fundraising and outreach. This is definitely something to celebrate!
  - At the craft fair, Chris Beloin (a Grace member and Thrivent rep) repeated that we are in the middle of the pack of churches for utilizing grants—some churches do upwards of \$20,000 a year—so having him speak with council at some point about new ideas and opportunities may be a good way to help everyone else understand how we can be even more effective in using these grants for all areas.
- Technology/PR Support
  - I will continue to post events and updates on Facebook as needed.
  - I am hoping to get trained on using the tech in the worship center
- Confirmation
  - Confirmation class has started again
  - Affirmation of Baptism service will be on May 15th
  - We will have 13 students confirmed this year
- KFC
  - KFC met on January 16. Our theme was ugly art. We worked on making ugly art projects.
  - Our next meeting is on Feb. 13. We will be going to the Concordia production of "The Little Mermaid".
- JYG
  - 12 JYG youth went Lasata Shopping in Dec.
  - JYG and HYPE youth helped deliver food to All Peoples' Church on Dec. 12
  - Winter/Spring 2022 events are still being scheduled
  - I plan on sending postcards to our JYG youth in February

- We found out last week that they have suspended registration for the youth gathering at this time because of covid.
