YOUTH AND FAMILY MINISTRY COMMITTEE: (Jen Jacobson)

We met on October 25th, Erica, Katie, Pat Murack, Sarah Newell, and myself were all in attendance. We discussed all upcoming events as well as how the Youth Groups are going. Upcoming Events:

- Bible Olympics (10/31 Sunday School)
 - Sunday School Children will enjoy a bunch of fun activities lead by Sunday School leaders.
 - Changes from last year are
 - Spread out through out the church verses in a condense area
 - Didn't advertise inviting a friend
- Trunk- or Treat (10/31 Congregational wide and community reach)

- Have 17-18 trunks (one of bigger years)
- 60 people are signed up
- Food will be served outside
- Youth are helping with this event
- Communion Instruction (Nov 7, 14th Receiving Frist Communion Nov. 21)
 - Katie is leading Communion instructions
 - Pastor Greg will meeting with the Group on the 14th
 - For all our 5th and 6th graders (we didn't have instruction last year) who haven't already starting communion, as well as any younger child that signed up.
- Bake Sale at Craft Fair (Youth Fundraiser for trips)
 - The youth will be selling baked goods verses a meal at this year craft fair instead to raise funds for youth trips
- Movie Night Showing of "The Star" (Dec 10th Congregational wide)
 - Applying for a Grant again to cover the cost of Pizza
 - Eating of pizza will be through out different rooms
 - Mask required during the movie in the Worship Center (past year we had 100 people)
 - Sign up for the pizza and advertising for us will start 10/31
- Christmas Program (12/19 Sunday School w/help from Youth)
 - Changes from last year to help lower risk
 - Only those with speaking parts and readings will participate in both Services
 - Sunday School Students will sign up for either 8am or 10:30am Worship with 25 spots open at both
 - Children will report to Fellowship but will sit with their families during the service (which allows them to also watch it!)
 - 1st graders might be asked play bells due to lower 3k-5k classes sizes and splitting the kids
 - Birthday Party for Jesus is undecided but we do have a plan for a low key possibly re-named event if we feel like we should have something between services.
 - Meals for All Peoples Katie and Erica are working on this Out Reach activity
 - Will have pull tags for items this year verse an open droop off
 - Youth will help take it down and carry it into All Peoples Church
 - Katie has reserved 50 Turkeys with Piggly Wiggly in Cedarburg they are also storing them until the food is taken down

Youth Groups

- Conformation is back to meeting
 - Still using Pastor Paul's written curium and adapting to their style if need be, will continue through the interim
 - Lead by both Erica and Pastor Greg, alternating weeks

 - Is back to meeting
 - o September was canceled due to lack of participants
 - October had good turn out and went well
 - Set to meet in November again
- JYG
 - Going well with about 10 every Sunday, sometimes up to 15
 - Frist event went will with about 10 kids
 - o December they will do service project for LaSata
- HYPE
 - Sundays have rotation of about 6-7 kids, averaging about 4 weekly
 - Not seeing many high school youth in worship, Worship Notes are not being completed
 - Service Project in December
 - Would like ideas to increased numbers of high school youth in worship, gathering, and events
 - Challenges: participation in sports, work, and not seeing them in worship.
 - Erica is going to connected with a group Youth Church leaders that is she is part of to see if they have any ideas
 - Pat is going to reach out to Youth.

Next Meeting was not set but we hope to meet in January or sooner if needed. **Katie:**

- Sunday School
 - Overall, we are having a good turnout at Sunday School. Attendance is a little down, and our 3K-5K classes have very small class sizes. But, all things considered, I am happy with the weekly turnout.
 - A huge thank you to all of our volunteers who are always quick to step up and fill in each week as we are finding that volunteers tests positive or are quarantined on an almost weekly basis. It is definitely a team effort and it is wonderful to have this support from our volunteers!
- All People's Christmas Meals
 - I have been working with All People's Church to coordinate the Christmas Meal donations again this year. Grace will be putting together 50 meals (so 100 bags of food), collecting \$1000 to cover the cost of the 50 turkeys and gathering 50 dozen cookies to go with the meals.
 - The donation board is going out on October 31. I'm really hoping this can be a great project for our congregation to rally around again this year.



- Refugee Donations
 - We continue to collect personal hygiene items for refugees that will be resettled in the Milwaukee area over the next few months.
 - This project will run through Oct 31.
- First Communion Classes
 - I currently have 9 students signed up to participate in first communion classes on Nov 7 and 14.
 - Pastor Greg will be joining the group on November 14 to walk the kids through a "practice" communion in the sanctuary.
 - We will lift up these young people in worship on November 21.
- Christmas Program Update
 - Our Christmas Program is set for Sunday, December 19 at both the 8:00 and 10:30 services.
 - New this year, we are going to have 3K-5th grade families sign up to attend one of these services. We think this will help us to have a great program with a reasonable amount of members and families at each service. I expect about 20-25 students to still participate in each service. So it will be less than usual, but still meaningful!
- Birthday Party for Jesus
 - We are still playing this by ear to see how the covid situation is at that time. If it seems OK, we will have something. If it doesn't seem wise, we will hold off on it this year.
- "The Star" Movie Night
 - We are excited to have the return of our annual Christmas movie night on Friday, December 10.
 - We will have pizza (folks can spread out in any room and eat, if they feel more comfortable) and watch the movie in the worship center.
- Thrivent Grants
 - As the end of the year approaches, I'm working with Thrivent members to match them with grant opportunities. If your committee has wants/needs for the remainder of the year, please let me know and we can try to get a Thrivent grant to help cover it. This is a great way to help the budget!
- Pastor Greg Arrival
 - We are so excited to finally have Pastor Greg here on staff!!
 - We've been working on sharing lots of info about Grace with him and getting him up to speed.
 - It is great to have him here!! It is really helping me to look forward to transition process of exploring where we are as a congregation and where we want to grow and build upon.
